## GRASS HEDGEHOGS

### WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- Old sock or pop-sock
- A cup
- An old spoon
- Elastic band
- Grass seed
- Soil/compost
- Water
- A saucer
- Old buttons(for face)



### WHAT YOU NEED TO DO:

- Wet an old sock or pop-sock and stretch it over the cup.
- Use a spoon to spread lots of grass seeds all over the bottom.
- Fill with the soil/compost.
- Wrap an elastic band tightly around the top of the sock/pop-sock. Chop off the rest.
- Take it out of the cup and put it upside down on a saucer and water.
- Glue or pin on the buttons to create face.
- Put your grass hedgehog into a warm, light room. Make sure you keep the top wet.
